

All mohair fleeces will go through the SVFF Sale. Please read directions carefully. If you are entering fleece for EAGMA Show judging you will need an EAGMA ID form in each fleece. If just for sale, you only need to have it on SVFF master form. All fleeces must go on the SVFF form, with their \$5 fee (no additional fee for the EAGMA show).

MOHAIR FLEECE SHOW & SALE RULES

1. Use the EAGMA Fleece ID Form for entering the EAGMA show competition. Fill out a form for each fleece entered. Fleeces to be judged will have both the EAGMA form and be listed on the SVFF master form.
2. All fleeces will be going through the SVFF Fleece sale. Please go to this link and follow their directions. Fleeces are to be listed on the SVFF master form and are charged a \$5 fee by SVFF. Fleeces will be entered in the Arts and Crafts Building on Friday, September 22nd, 2017 from 10am to 4pm. <http://www.shenandoahvalleyfiberfestival.com/>
3. Fleece must have been grown by the producer. The fiber must be from the past 12 month's growth.
4. The fleece is shown raw, skirted and presented as "ready to sell". It should be free of excessive vegetative matter, dung tags, etc.
5. Colored and white fleeces will be judged separately, in their own shows.
6. Categories will be kid (1st clip/2nd clip), yearling (3rd clip/4th clip), and adult in each show. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 5th places in each category in both white and colored shows. Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded in each show.
7. You may "sell only" washed fleece. They will not be judged.
